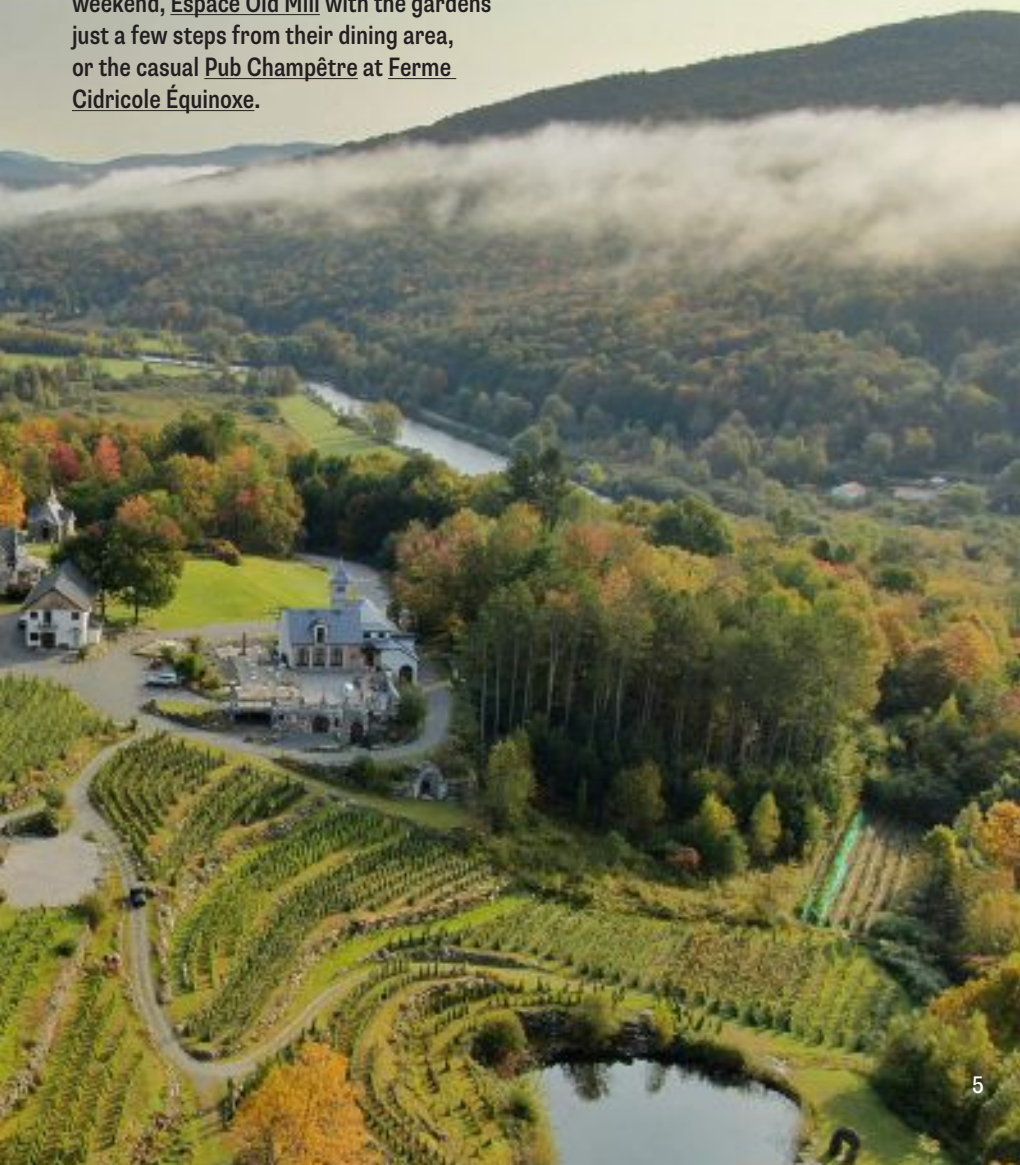
Good to Know
